Samson: What God Sees "Failure and Redemption" Judges 16

There is a strange, even ironic, theme throughout the Scriptures. Paul tells the Corinthians that "the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men" (1 Cor. 1:25); and "when I am weak, then I am strong" (2 Cor. 12:10). Similarly, Judges 16 begins with a strong man who is revealed to be weak, but ends with a weak man who is stronger than ever he was before. This lesson is Samson's real legacy.
